Question	DO you learn English? <i>Yes, I do. / No, I don't.</i> What time DO they get up ?	DOES she dance ? <i>Yes, she does. / No, she doesn't.</i> Where DOES he go to school?
Time expressions	every day, every week, every Friday,... on Monday, on Fridays,... at the weekends, once a week, twice a month, three times a year,...	
Adverbs of frequency	always (vždy), sometimes (niekedy), often (často), usually (zvyčajne) normally (bežne), never (nikdy), hardly ever (sotvakedy)	

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
